

PRIVACY POLICY

Aurumity Limited understands that your privacy is important to you and that you care about how your information is used and shared online. The Company respects and values the privacy of everyone who visits the Website and will only collect and use information in ways that are useful to you and in a manner consistent with your rights and Company's obligations under the law.

This Privacy Policy applies to the Company's use of any and all data collected by the Company in relation to your use of the Website. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully and ensure that you understand it. Your acceptance of the Company's Privacy Policy is deemed to occur upon your first use of the Website. You will be also required to read and accept this Privacy Policy when signing up for an Account. If you do not accept and agree with this Privacy Policy, you must stop using the Website immediately.

1. LANGUAGE

This Privacy Policy is supplied to you in English and the Company will continue to communicate with you in English for the duration of this Privacy Policy. However, where possible, the Company will communicate with you in other languages in addition to English.

2. HEADINGS

Headings are for ease of reference only and do not form part of this Privacy Policy.

3. MEANINGS

In this Privacy Policy the following terms shall have the following meanings:

"Account" means an account required to access and/or use certain areas and features of the Website;

"Company" means Aurumity Limited a limited company registered in Republic of Cyprus with registration number HE 344138, the whose registered address is Inomenon Ethnon, 44, ORTHODOXOU TOWER, 6042, Larnaca, Cyprus.

"Cookie" means a small text file placed on your computer or device by the Website when you visit certain parts of the Website and/or when you use certain features of the Website;

"UK and EU Cookie Law" means the relevant parts of the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 as amended in 2004, 2011 and 2015;

"Website" means the website that you are currently using aurumity.com;

4. COLLECTION YOUR DATA

Some data will be collected automatically by the Website, other data will only be collected if you voluntarily submit it, for example, when signing up for an Account or filling up the contact form. In this respect, the Company gathers data from you and may, in certain circumstances, gather data from banks and/or credit agencies, and/or clearing agencies and/or other sources which will help the Company to construct your profile based on your requirements and preferences in order to provide Company's services effectively. The data which Company collects includes information required to communicate with and identify you. The Company may also collect certain demographic data, including, birth date, education, occupation, etc.

5. USAGE YOUR DATA

All personal data is stored securely in accordance with the principles of the Data Protection Act 1998. The Company uses your data to provide the best possible products and services to you.

With your permission and/or where permitted by law, the Company may also use your data for marketing purposes which may include contacting you by email AND/OR telephone AND/OR text message AND/OR post with information, news and offers on the Company's products AND/OR services. The Company will not, however, send you any unsolicited marketing or spam and will take all reasonable steps to ensure that the Company fully protects your rights and comply with Company's obligations under the Data Protection Act 1998 and the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003, as amended in 2004, 2011 and 2015.

The Company uses your personal information only as required to provide quality service and security to you. This information helps the Company to improve the Company's services, customize browsing experience and enables it to inform you of additional products, services or promotions relevant to you and in this respect, you hereby consent to the usage of this data for such purposes. 6. PROTECTION YOUR DATA

The Company only keeps your data for as long as the Company needs to use it and/or for as long as the Company has your permission to keep it.

Some or all of your data may be stored or transferred outside of the European Economic Area ("the EEA") (The EEA consists of all EU member states, plus Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein). You are deemed to accept and agree to this by using the Website and submitting information to the Company. If the Company stores or transfers data outside the EEA, the Company will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your data is treated as safely and securely as it would be within the EEA and under the Data Protection Act 1998. Such steps may include, but not be limited to, the use of legally binding contractual terms between the Company and any third parties the Company engages and the use of the EU-approved Model Contractual Arrangements.

Data security is of great importance to the Company, and to protect your data the Company has put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure data collected through the Website.

Steps the Company takes to secure and protect your data include:

- Strong SSL Certificate Encryption.
- The using hetzner.com email services, which are highly secured.
- The following strict internal procedures when handling any sensitive data.

Notwithstanding the security measures that the Company takes, it is important to remember that the transmission of data via the internet may not be completely secure and that you are advised to take suitable precautions when transmitting to the Company data via the internet.

7. SHARING YOUR DATA

The Company may sometimes have contracts with third parties to supply products and services to you on the Company's behalf. These may include payment processing, delivery of goods, search engine facilities, advertising, and marketing. In some cases, the third parties may require access to some or all of your data. Where any of your data is required for such a purpose, the Company will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your data will be handled safely, securely, and in accordance with your rights, the Company's obligations, and the obligations of the third party under the law.

The Company may compile statistics about the use of the Website including data on traffic, usage patterns, user numbers, sales and other information. All such data will be anonymized and will not include any personally identifying information. The Company may from time to time share such data with third

parties such as prospective investors, affiliates, partners and advertisers. Data will only be shared and used within the bounds of the law.

In certain circumstances, the Company may be legally required to share certain data held by the Company, which may include your personal information, for example, where the Company is involved in legal proceedings, where the Company is complying with the requirements of legislation, a court order, or a governmental authority. The Company do not requires any further consent from you in order to share your data in such circumstances and will comply as required with any legally binding request that is made of the Company.

8. CONTROL YOUR DATA

When you submit information via the Website, you may be given options to restrict the Company's use of your data. In particular, the Company aims to give you strong controls on the Company's use of your data for direct marketing purposes (including the ability to opt-out of receiving emails from the Company which you may do by unsubscribing using the links provided in the Company's emails).

9. RESTRICTION OF RESPONSIBILITY

The Company is not responsible for the privacy policies or the content of sites to which trotort.com links and has no control of the use or protection of information provided by you or collected by those sites. Whenever you elect to link to a co-branded web site or to a linked web site, you may be asked to provide registration or other personal information. Please note that such information is recorded by a third party and will be governed by the privacy policy of that third party.

10. COOKIES

"Cookies" are small pieces of information that are transferred to your browser and stored on your computer's hard drive. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually change your browser to prevent that if you would rather not store the information for future use.

The Company uses cookies to secure your activities and to enhance the performance of the Website. Cookies used by the Company do not contain personal information or other sensitive information. The Company may share the Website usage statistics with reputable advertising companies and with its affiliated marketing companies. It is noted that the information collected by such advertising companies is not personally identifiable. To administer and improve the Website, the Company may use third parties to track and analyze usage and statistical volume information. The third party may use cookies to track behavior and may set cookies on behalf of the Company. The Company may also collect certain technical and routing information about your computer to facilitate your use of the Website and its services. These cookies do not contain any personally identifiable information.

11. UPDATES

The Company may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. In the event that the Company materially changes this Privacy Policy including how it collects, processes or uses your personal information, the revised Privacy Policy will be uploaded on the Website. In this respect, you hereby agree to accept posting of a revised Privacy Policy electronically on the Website as the actual notice of the Company to you. The Company encourages you to periodically review this Privacy Policy so that you are always aware of what information the Company collects, how it uses it and to whom it may disclose it, in accordance with the provisions of this Privacy Policy.
